Learning sound by sound

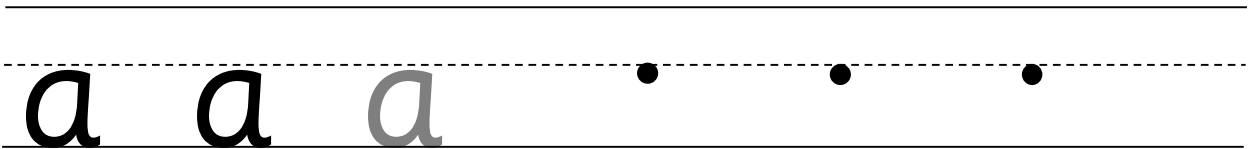


Tip for mom: Help your child to correctly form the 'a' sound on as many surfaces as possible while saying the name of the sound.
