

7 - 3 = 4

Joshua has 4 marbles left.

There are **8** birds on a wire. **5** Birds flew away. How many birds are left on the wire?



8 - 5 = \_\_\_\_

8 - 5 = 3

There are **3 birds** left on the wire.



$$9 - 7 = 2$$

Sam has 2 blocks left.

There are **9 kids** on the bus. **5 kids** got off. How many **kids** are <u>left</u> on the bus?



9 - 5 =

9 - 5 = 4

There are **4 kids** on the bus.

Glen planted 12 flowers. Only 3 flowers are growing. How many flowers still need to grow?



12 - 9 = \_\_\_\_

12 - 9 = 3

9 Flowers still need to grow.

13 - 8 = 5

Roelf drew 5 triangles.

Sally has **9** dresses. There are **4** pink dresses. How many green dresses does she <u>have</u>?



9 - 4 = \_\_\_

9 - 4 = 5

Sally has **5 green dresses**.

12 - 5 = 7

Miss. Jones has **7 stars** left.

Sue has 12 shoes to give to people. How many people can she give the shoes to?



Sue can give shoes to 6 people.

Jane has **9 cards** to <u>share between **3 friends**</u>. How many **cards** will <u>each friend get?</u>



Each friend will get 3 cards.
