Question 2: Refer to the recipe below and answer the questions which follow:

Ingredients:

| 2 cups of self-raising flour | -3/4 cup grated cheese |
| 1/2 cup bacon | -1/4 cup chopped mushrooms |
| 125g butter (melted) | -1 cup milk |
| 1 egg beaten | -1 tbsp parsley |

Method:

1. Preheat oven to 180 C and grease a 12 cup muffin tray.
2. In a bowl, place the flour, parsley, grated cheese, mushrooms and bacon.
3. In a jug, combine the egg, milk and butter.
4. Pour the wet ingredients into the dry ingredients and mix until combined.
5. Pour the mixture into the muffin tray and bake for 15-20 minutes.
6. Serve with butter and enjoy.

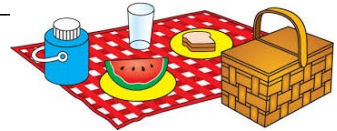
