

#### Incident number 1:

- 2 Sam can ask Peter why he does not have his own pencils and maybe involve the teacher to make sure Peter has his own stationery.
- 3 Sam can apologise for hitting Peter.

#### Incident number 2:

a) Describe why the situation in in incident number 2 can be described as a conflict situation. (Keep in mind the definition of conflict).

Conflict is when two or more people disagree about something. Tony and his mom disagrees about whether he needs to have his hair cut.

b) Do you think it will be a positive response to the conflict situation if his mom keeps on arguing with him every time he has to go to the hairdresser? Explain your answer.

Arguing about the same situation will not resolve the conflict. They should find a solution to the problem.

c) Can you think of any positive way to possibly resolve this conflict situation?
Tony's mom should speak to him when she is calm and ask him why he has such a problem with having his hair cut. They can make a plan that both agree upon,
e.g. a day that suits Tony or maybe he doesn't like the hairdresser. They should find a solution that both agree to.
